 2. your data from any sensitive information (password, identities, etc.)
6. If you are working with pictures
 1. If an image is in your clipboard (screenshot), you can paste it in edit mode (see [imgpaste plugin](#) for more details.
 2. If it's in a file, you have to upload it using the [media manager](#)
7. It is recommended to use the DokuWiki syntax. However, if you already have documentation in markdown and you cannot “translate” to DokuWiki syntax, then you can try to paste it between `<markdown>` and `</markdown>` elements.
